



## MAIN DINING ROOM & MAIN LOUNGE DRESS AND CELL PHONE ETIQUETTE

Club Casual is the appropriate dress for a la carte dinner, Happy Hour, Club Special Events, etc...

Shorts, tee shirts, athletic apparel, bathing suits, etc...are not permitted.

Gentlemen may be more comfortable in a sport coat after 6:00 p.m.

“Dressy” jeans are allowed but not recommended (no rips, tears, etc...).

Denim of any kind is not permitted at Club Special Events such as Mother’s Day Brunch, Easter Brunch etc...

Gentlemen must remove their hat while inside the Clubhouse.

The use of cell phones in the Main Dining Room or Main Lounge is not permitted.

## GRILL ROOM DRESS AND CELL PHONE ETIQUETTE

Golf attire or Club Casual clothing is the appropriate dress in the Grill Room.

“Dressy” jeans are permitted in the Grill Room (no rips, tears, etc...).

Bathing suits, tank tops or sleeveless shirts (for men), spandex athletic clothes, etc...or not permitted.

Gentlemen must remove their hat while inside the Clubhouse.

The use of cell phones to check emails or texts is permitted in the Grill Room.

Please be courteous to your fellow members and excuse yourself to a private location if you must use your cell phone.

## FITNESS CENTER RULES, DRESS AND ETIQUETTE

All members and members’ guests must sign in at the Reception Desk upon arrival.

No one under the age of 16 years old is permitted to use the facility unless supervised by an adult.

Appropriate workout clothing is required while using the Fitness Center facility.

Bathing suits, street clothes, bare feet, etc...are not permitted.

Men are required to wear a shirt while working out; no bare upper bodies.

Personal listening devices (headphones, ear buds) must be used if listening to music.

Any music device that can be heard by others is not permitted.

Food, drink (other than water or sports drinks) are not allowed in the Fitness facility.

Smoking is not allowed in the Fitness facility.

All equipment must be wiped down after each use.

Return all equipment (dumbbells, mats, etc...) to its original location after each use.

Please be courteous and respectful of others while using the facility.
