

CLUB PONTOON BOAT GUIDELINES

We are excited to announce that Lake Nona Golf & Country Club has purchased a new pontoon boat for Members to enjoy with one another, their families and guests. Guidelines worth noting:

- The boat will be rented in four (4) hour increments.
- Reservations are to be made through the Bath & Racquet app, [view download instructions](#).
- The boat can be used for fishing, swimming and cruising.
- Similar to a car rental, Members are required to complete necessary paperwork and assume responsibility of the boat for the duration of the rental.
- Minimum age requirements: 18 years old to drive boat; 25 years old to rent boat.
- The cost will be \$250 for the four hours and includes the following:
 - Taking the boat out of storage and launching it into the water.
 - Cleaning the boat, pulling it out of the water and putting it back into storage.
 - Fuel
 - Personal floatation devices / life jackets
 - \$50 food and beverage credit during rental, which includes dockside delivery.
- If multiple families or couples rent the boat, the charge will be split accordingly.
- A strictly enforced maximum of 10 people will be allowed on the boat.
- Watersports (i.e. - tubing, wakeboarding, waterskiing and wake surfing) are not permitted.

ADDITIONAL DOCK & LAKE INFORMATION

- The dock is a Lake Nona Golf & Country Club amenity and asset. The dock is easily damaged when boats are left tied to it during high wind and storms. In order to protect the Club's asset and meet South Florida Water Management District regulations, it is **imperative that boats are removed from the water daily**.
- Any boat remaining on the dock at dusk will be removed, returned to boat storage and a \$35 charge will be billed to your Member account.
- Effective immediately, the Club will now offer the following boat valet services for all Member-owned boats, which can be billed to your Member account:
 - Complete Valet Service (boat launch and return to storage), \$50
 - Single Valet Service (launch or return to storage), \$35
 - Fuel services available at a rate of \$3.80/gallon
 - For boat valet or fuel services, contact Victor Rodriguez, 407-697-7455.
- Paddleboards can be reserved through the Bath & Racquet app and are available complimentary Monday – Saturday, 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.
- Once the COVID-19 regulations have been lifted and Club operations return to normal, the Club will begin offering the following additional Bath & Racquet services:
 - Private watersport lessons through Nautique.
 - Fishing lessons/instruction and private, guided fishing excursions.
- Lake operations are set forth by [Lake Nona's Lake Management Plan](#), created by the South Florida Water Management District. A few items worth noting:
 - Personal watercraft (jet skis) are not permitted on the lakes.
 - Boats must be registered with Lake Nona Security and display a valid, Security-issued registration sticker. For forms and information, please email smarks@lakenona.com.
 - Boats cannot be greater than 23 feet in length.
 - Boats are not permitted to be left in the water overnight.
